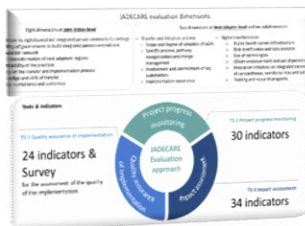


Métodos JADECARE de un vistazo: marco de evaluación para transferir Buenas Prácticas a los Próximos Adoptadores



JADECARE

Este artículo proporciona un resumen de los métodos de evaluación de **JADECARE** y, por lo tanto, demuestra la amplitud y riqueza de los resultados de la evaluación en preparación. La puesta en práctica del marco de evaluación dio como resultado **un total de 88 indicadores (indicadores de proceso, producto o resultado)**, donde 30 indicadores están relacionados con el seguimiento del progreso del proyecto, 24 con el aseguramiento de la calidad de la implementación y 34 con la evaluación del impacto (ver imagen principal / cifras).



Se destacarán más detalles en un artículo específico en el próximo boletín (2023-2) y, por supuesto, a través del informe final sobre los resultados del proyecto.

1st International Annual Workshop for the search of Synergies of the Partnership ERA4Health

ERA4Health is a European Partnership addressed to foster a European Research Area for Health Research (<https://era4health.eu/>).

This Partnership brings the opportunity to increase European transnational collaborative research funding by creating a funding body for joint programming in priority areas addressing European public health needs.

The EU-funded ERA4Health Partnership brings together 32 entities and 28 funding organisations from 22 countries, with the common goal of fostering high-impact translational research for addressing public health needs.

Through cross-national joint calls for proposals and making the most of interregional and international cooperation, ERA4Health aims to provide influential contributions as well as a sustainable model of funding for ground-breaking translational research in the health domain across Europe and beyond.

Creating synergies with other related initiatives sharing the some of the ERA4-Health specific objectives is essential to avoid overlap and duplication of national and EU research funding. The ERA4Health Partnership is organizing an international workshop to promote collaboration and interactions at a transnational level, towards a European (and beyond) Research Area in Health Research. The main aim of this workshop is to explore synergies between activities in ERA4Health and other relevant networks and to facilitate their alignment with national policies. More than 50 initiatives at European and international level will be presented by the members of a Synergies Working Group (SWG) set up for this purpose.
